The Polk County Board of Supervisors met as a Canvassing Board on Thursday, September 25, 2003 at 1:00 p.m. to canvass votes cast in the Special Altoona City Election held on September 23, 2003.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Robert Brownell, John Mauro.

The members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of County Canvassers, for this County, hereby certify the following to be a true and correct abstract of the votes cast in this County at the Special Altoona City Election held on the Twenty-third Day of September, 2003.

For the Office of Council Member To Fill Vacancy (1 To Be Elected) there were 613 votes cast, of which Jeff Ferriss had 76 votes, Charles E. Franklin Jr. had 209 votes, Marie Kunkle-Nagel had 36 votes, Gerald B. Jerry Nolin had 277 votes, Michael Schrodt had 14 votes and Scattering had 1 vote. Charles E. Franklin Jr. and Gerald B. Jerry Nolin advanced to run-off.
