PROCEEDINGS OF THE POLK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Polk County Board of Supervisors met as a Canvassing Board on Friday, September 16, 2005 at 10:00 a.m. to canvass votes cast for the Polk County School Elections and Des Moines Area Community College held on September 13, 2005.

MEMBERS PRESENT: E.J. Giovannetti, Robert Brownell, John Mauro, Angela Connolly,
Tom Hockensmith.

For the Office of Director, Ankeny Community School District (3 To be Elected) there were 6,606 votes cast, of which Joe Morr had 1,166 votes, Sue Nelson had 897 votes, Paula Pearson had 1,709 votes, Leslie R. Petersen had 1,405 votes, Denny Presnall had 1,403 votes, and Write-In had 26 votes. Paula Pearson, Leslie R. Petersen, and Denny Presnall were elected.

For the Office of Director, Bondurant-Farrar Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 102 votes cast, of which Bill Elson had 48 votes, Warren Nielsen had 53 votes, and Write-In had 1 vote. Bill Elson and Warren Nielsen were elected.

For the Office of Director District #3, Dallas Center Grimes Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 115 votes cast, of which Leann Goldsmith had 115 votes, and Write-In had 0 votes. Leann Goldsmith was elected.

For the Office of Director District #4, Dallas Center Grimes Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 76 votes cast, of which Kathie L. Hicok had 76 votes, and Write-In had 0 votes. Kathie L. Hicok was elected.

For the Office of Director At Large, Dallas Center Grimes Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 250 votes cast, of which Douglas Rothfus had 250 votes, and Write-In had 0 votes. Douglas Rothfus was elected.

For the Office of Director At Large (To Fill Vacancy), Dallas Center Grimes Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 274 votes cast, of which Angela Glasgow had 209 votes, Larry E. Lubinus had 65 votes, and Write-In had 0 votes. Angela Glasgow was elected.

For the Office of Director, Des Moines Independent Community School District (3 To be Elected) there were 29,447 votes cast, of which Margaret Borgen had 4,161 votes, Michael Howland had 757 votes, Trudy McCormick had 2,361 votes, Dick Murphy had 4,669 votes, Jonathan Narcisse had 4,234 votes, Jim Patch had 4,057 votes, Virginia Strong had 4,320 votes, Jeanette R. Woods had 4,823 votes, and Write-In had 65 votes. Dick Murphy, Virginia Strong and Jeanette R. Woods were elected.

For the Office of Director, Johnston Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 2,213 votes cast, of which Robert J. Cramer had 501 votes, Jill M. Morrill had 936 votes, Write-In had 776 votes, Write-In (Dean Gillaspey) had 768 votes, and Scattering had 8 votes. Jill M. Morrill and Dean Gillaspey were elected.

For the Office of Director, North Polk Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 645 votes cast, of which Aaron Heley Lehman had 318 votes, Larry Matijevich had 299 votes, and Write-In had 28 votes. Aaron Heley Lehman and Larry Matijevich were elected.

Public Measure Letter A for the Special Proposition, Summarized Proposition, Shall the following Public Measure be Adopted? Shall the Board of Directors of the North Polk Community School District, in the Counties of Polk, Boone, and Story, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to levy and impose a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not to exceed Sixty-seven Cents (67¢) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the School District, commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007? There were 391 votes cast, of which 217 votes were for the proposition, and 174 votes were against the proposition. The proposition was approved.

For the Office of Director, Saydel Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 95 votes cast, of which Brian Bowman had 47 votes, Paul Breitbarth had 46 votes, and Write-In had 2 votes. Brian Bowman and Paul Breitbarth were elected.

For the Office of Director, Southeast Polk Community School District (3 To be Elected) there were 2,287 votes cast, of which Steven F. Hanson had 476 votes, Andrew J. McGrean had 429 votes, Brad Skinner had 575 votes, Write-In had 807 votes, Write-In (Jack Scignoli) had 272 votes, Write-In (Bruce Cox) had 256 votes, Write-In (Richard Wilson) had 246 votes, and Scattering had 33 votes. Steven F. Hanson, Andrew J. McGrean and Brad Skinner were elected.

For the Office of Director, Urbandale Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 251 votes cast, of which Cynthia Munyon had 111 votes, Jerry Tormey had 124 votes, and Write-In had 16 votes. Cynthia Munyon and Jerry Tormey were elected.

For the Office of Director, West Des Moines Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 518 votes cast, of which Thomas Suckow had 259 votes, Terry Tobin had 253 votes, and Write-In had 6 votes. Thomas Suckow and Terry Tobin were elected.

For the Office of Director District #2, Des Moines Area Community College (1 To be Elected) there were 1,113 votes cast, of which Wayne E. Rouse had 1,068 votes, and Write-In had 45 votes.

For the Office of Director District #6, Des Moines Area Community College (1 To be Elected) there were 1,885 votes cast, of which Ben Norman had 1,854 votes, and Write-In had 31 votes.

For the Office of Director District #7, Des Moines Area Community College (1 To be Elected) there were 1,929 votes cast, of which Madelyn K. Tursi had 1,871 votes, and Write-In had 58 votes.

For the Office of Director District #9 (To Fill Vacancy), Des Moines Area Community College (1 To be Elected) there were 337 votes cast, of which Jim Crawford had 334 votes, and Write-In had 3 votes.
