PROCEEDINGS OF THE POLK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Board of Supervisors met as a Canvassing Board on Thursday, November 10, 2005 at 1:00 p.m. Due to lack of a quorum the meeting was reconvened until 1:30 p.m.

The Polk County Board of Supervisors met in reconvened session at 1:30 p.m. to canvass votes cast for the Run-off Cities Election held on November 8, 2005.

MEMBERS PRESENT: E.J. Giovannetti, Robert Brownell, Tom Hockensmith.
MEMBERS ABSENT: John Mauro, Angela Connolly.

For the Office of Mayor – City of West Des Moines (1 to be elected) there were 3,725 votes cast, of which Eugene T. Meyer had 3,619 votes and Scattering had 106 votes. Eugene T. Meyer was elected.

For the Office of Council Member At Large – City of West Des Moines (1 to be elected) there were 3,973 votes cast, of which Ted Ohmart had 2,399 votes, Bob Quinn had 1,559 votes and Scattering had 15 votes. Ted Ohmart was elected.

For the Office of Council Member Ward 1 – City of West Des Moines (1 to be elected) there were 1,151 votes cast, of which John J. McGinn had 290 votes, Robert L. Parks had 533 votes, Kevin L. Trevillya had 324 votes and Scattering had 4 votes. Robert L. Parks and Kevin L. Trevillyan were nominated.

For the Office of Council Member Ward 3 – City of West Des Moines (1 to be elected) there were 2,132 votes cast, of which Ryan R. Anderson had 442 votes, Loretta J. Sieman had 1,109 votes, Russ Trimble had 576 votes and Scattering had 5 votes. Loretta J. Sieman was elected.

For the Office of Park Commissioner – City of West Des Moines (2 to be elected) there were 5,321 votes cast, of which Chris Andrews had 1,653 votes, Marcia Brown had 2,111 votes, John Micka had 1,516 votes and Scattering had 41 votes. Chris Andrews and Marcia Brown were elected.

For the Office of Mayor – City of Windsor Heights (1 to be elected) there were 745 votes cast, of which Jerry Sullivan had 722 votes and Scattering had 23 votes. Jerry Sullivan was elected.

For the Office of Council Member – City of Windsor Heights (3 to be elected) there were 2,282 votes cast, of which Flo Hunter had 535 votes, Stephen B. Peterson had 409 votes, Angie Piziali had 213 votes, Carole A. Tillotson had 411 votes, Diana Willits had 511 votes, Kathy Witkovski had 195 votes and Scattering had 8 votes. Flo Hunter, Carole A. Tillotson and Diana Willits were elected.

For Public Measure Letter A Shall the Following Public Measure Be Adopted? “Shall the City of Windsor Heights in the County of Polk, State of Iowa, reserve the right to be authorized to establish a Municipally-owned Communications Utility?” There were 799 votes cast, of which 354 votes were for the proposition, and 445 votes were against the proposition. The proposition was not approved.
