## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE POLK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

The Polk County Board of Supervisors met as a Canvassing Board on Friday, September 15, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. to canvass votes cast for the Polk County School Elections and Des Moines Area Community College Elections held on September 12, 2006.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Robert Brownell, Tom Hockensmith, John Mauro.

MEMBERS ABSENT: E.J. Giovannetti, Angela Connolly.

For the Office of Director, Ankeny Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 4,715 votes cast, of which Bill Dickey had 422 votes, Randy R. McMahill had 1,590 votes, Deb Russell had 823 votes, Bryan Tjaden had 339 votes, George Tracy had 1,106 votes, Rob Tucker had 389 votes, and Scattering had 46 votes. Randy R. McMahill and George Tracy were elected.

For the Office of Director, Bondurant-Farrar Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 206 votes cast, of which Allison Patton Bishop had 148 votes, Laurie Phelan had 57 votes, and Scattering had 1 vote. Let the record show corrections were made on polling places due to numbers being sent through the system twice. Allison Patton Bishop was elected.

For the Office of Director District #2, Dallas Center-Grimes Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 73 votes cast, of which Scott D. Brown had 72 votes, and Scattering had 1 vote. Scott D. Brown was elected.

For the Office of Director At Large, Dallas Center-Grimes Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 337 votes cast, of which Del Gustafson had 177 votes, Ronald L. Wiedman had 159 votes, and Scattering had 1 vote. Del Gustafson was elected.

For the Office of Director, Des Moines Independent Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 12,785 votes cast, of which Connie Boesen had 4,835 votes, Teree Caldwell-Johnson had 4,292 votes, Flossie Dusek had 3,527 votes, and Scattering had 131 votes. Let The Record Show corrections were made on polling places due to numbers being sent through the system twice. Connie Boesen and Teree Caldwell-Johnson were elected.

For the Office of Director, Johnston Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 1,845 votes cast, of which Tracey Orman had 501 votes, Christopher T. Sonner had 645 votes, Ralph T. Young, Jr. had 693 votes, and Scattering had 6 votes. Christopher T. Sonner and Ralph T. Young, Jr. were elected.

For the Office of Director (To Fill Vacancy), Johnston Community School District (1 To be Elected) there were 1,115 votes cast, of which Matt Brown had 449 votes, Karen F. Coaldrake had 664 votes, and Scattering had 2 votes. Karen F. Coaldrake was elected.

For the Office of Director, North Polk Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 1,772 votes cast, of which Larry R. Greene had 372 votes, Connie Pitcher had 197 votes, Write-In (Aric Sharp) had 443 votes, Write-In (Diane Lackore) had 420 votes, Write-In (Steve Holland) had 325 votes, and Scattering had 15 votes. Aric Sharp and Diane Lackore were elected.

For the Office of Director, Saydel Community School district (2 To be Elected) there were 95 votes cast, of which Ray Livingston had 44 votes, Melissa Sassman had 48 votes, and Scattering had 3 votes. Ray Livingston and Melissa Sassman were elected.

For the Office of Director, Southeast Polk Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 2,588 votes cast, of which Thomas B. Hadden III had 719 votes, Tim Mallicoat had 540 votes, Joanne Moeller had 655 votes, Jack Scignoli had 376 votes, Richard H. Wilson had 296 votes, and Scattering had 2 votes. Thomas B. Hadden III and Joanne Moeller were elected.

For the Office of Director, Urbandale Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 255 votes cast, of which Jeffrey D. Farrell had 115 votes, Diana Ripperger had 127 votes, and Scattering had 13 votes. Jeffrey D. Farrell and Diana Ripperger were elected.

For the Office of Director, West Des Moines Community School District (2 To be Elected) there were 1,811 votes cast, of which Barbara B. Burnett had 762 votes, Jill Hansen had 746 votes, and Scattering had 303 votes. Barbara B. Burnett and Jill Hansen were elected.

For the Office of Director District #4, Des Moines Area Community College (1 To be Elected) there were 142 votes cast, of which Kevin Halterman had 134 votes, and Scattering had 8 votes. Kevin Halterman was nominated.

For the Office of Director District #5, Des Moines Area Community College (1 To be Elected) there were 656 votes cast, of which Joseph L. Pugel had 635 votes, and Scattering had 21 votes. Joseph L. Pugel was nominated.
